

## Brockton Public Schools

BPS outperforms similar school districts on the state assessments.

### District Information

Brockton Public Schools, the fourth largest school district in Massachusetts, supports 24 schools serving over 15,000 students. Its diverse student body has a high number of low income, special needs and limited English proficient students. The challenge of meeting AYP has been accomplished by paying close attention to and acting on information gleaned from the annual state assessments, and by initiating an extensive common assessment program. For over 8 years, Brockton has used TestWiz, developed and supported by dataMetrics Software to analyze MCAS data. This September, the district expanded the use of TestWiz, to score and report on all its local assessments. Brockton chose TestWiz because it offers great value, is easy to use, accommodates multiple assessments, and it brings meaningful data right to the classroom teacher.

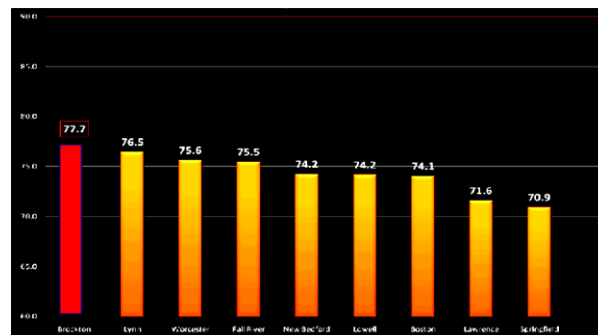

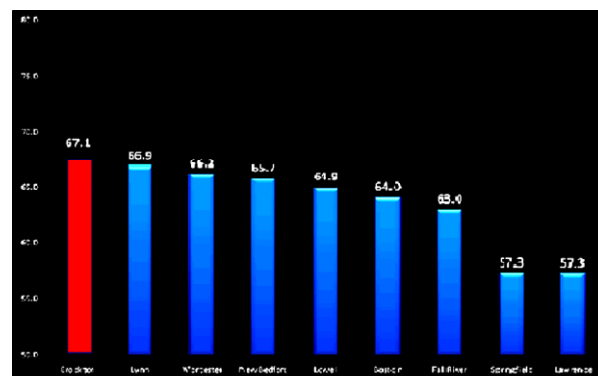
